### **MILK COMPETITION WINNER FOR CLASS 1 ANNOUNCED!**

**JOSHUA VALERE of St. Angela’s Primary was revealed as the Class 1 winner of the Pine Hill Dairy World School Milk Day competition this morning.**

He along with the other winning students – whose names will be revealed this week during morning assemblies – have each won a Kindle Fire HD tablet which Pine Hill Dairy Category Manager **Henry Yearwood** hopes will help to continue to instill the obvious love for reading which the essay winners have displayed.

Last week, the four winning primary schools learned the good news. St. Angela’s Primary produced the Class 1 winner, the Class 2 winner is from Reynold Weekes Primary, a student from All Saints Primary copped the prize for Class 3 and a Roland Edwards Primary school student won the prize for Class 4.

The winning schools have also each won \$1,000 in cash.

A rousing applause erupted when Mr. Yearwood brought the good news and read the winning Class 1 essay.

Mr. Yearwood described it as “a great feeling” to be a part of the Pine Hill Dairy project.

More than 750 essays were entered into the competition from 62 of the 79 public schools across the island as well as each of the 15 private schools in the inaugural Pine Hill Dairy national competition.

Class 1 to Class 4 students were asked to submit essays which began **“My parents should ensure I drink milk each day because ...”** when the competition was launched on World School Milk Day.
